Subject: Regarding initiating inquiry against 'AMG India International' Chilakaluripet, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh and further cancellation of FCRA registration of the said institution

Sir

National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) is a statutory body constituted under Section 3 of Commissions for Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005, which is entrusted with the protection, promotion and monitoring of child rights and other matters related or incidental thereto. NCPCR as per its mandate u/s 13 (1) (j) had taken suo-motu cognizance of a complaint received with regard to imposing Christian Religious views on minor students by AMG Group of Institutions, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh.

- 2. It has been observed by the Commission through the said complaint that the afore-mentioned Institution is involved in various irregularities under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Act, 2015 as well as violation of the FCRA Act. The said Institution has been in receipt of foreign funding for the purpose of religious and children welfare activities since the financial year 2006-07 and it is noticed that the foreign organizations making funding to the Institution have been uploading sensitive data of minor children staying/taking shelter at different homes/institute of the said Institution like images, videos, date of birth, age etc. on their official websites. Further the Commission has also been informed that the said Institution has also been involved in imposing Christian religious views on minors and cognizance of the same has also been taken by the Commission. - 3. Hence, it is necessary to examine the FCRA grants received by AMG Group of Institutions, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh. The Commission u/s 15 (i) of the CPCR Act, 2005 recommends that an inquiry may be conducted for violations of provisions of FCRA 2010.
- 4. Therefore, in view of the above, the Commission requests the Ministry of Home Affairs to investigate into the sources and utilization of the foreign funds of the said Institution and requests to immediately prohibit the receipt of foreign funds as per Section 9 of the FCRA, 2010 by the Institution, in view of public interest and sovereignty and integrity of the country. The Commission further recommends and requests the Ministry for cancellation of FCRA certificate under Section 14 of the FCRA, 2010 of the said Institution as well, as it is necessary in the public interest to do so.
